Physical Therapist (PT)

The PT is responsible for the delivery of skilled patient care in a safe and timely manner to all of those referred for services. Testing, examining and evaluating impairments, movement dysfunctions, and disabilities or other health and movement-related conditions in order to determine a diagnosis, prognosis, and plan of intervention, and to assess the outcomes of intervention.

Viable candidates must have a degree or certificate in Physical Therapy from an accredited school (minimum requirement is a certificate or Bachelors Degree). Previous outpatient experience preferred and BLS required.

Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA)

The PTA assists with restoration of patient functioning to prevent disability following injury, disease or physical disability.
